 - Moderate Techniques: Expansion patterning (i.e. 5-in-1), complex shaping for curves and angles, use of riveted rings
 - Advanced Technique: Incorporation of multiple ring patterns for functional and/or decorative use, use of small/fine ring sizes, incorporation of non-mail elements (leather, metal plates, etc.), self-made rings
 - Use of period appropriate materials and tools.
 - Use of period techniques.
